#### How many trees to plant?

#### How long does it take to plant?

30 very relaxed volunteer planters planted 600 trees in 1.5 hours = 13 trees per person per hour I'd say 13 to 20 trees per hour per planter is a good rule of thumb.

#### **Component costs:**

Forestry tube trees \$1.15 - \$2ea 1600 Tree guards - \$0.76 - 1.70ea 1400 https://www.arborgreen.com.au/product/2631-corflute-welded-guard-450mm-high-200mm-sides

Hardwood stakes – \$0.66 - 0.76ea (1 or 2 per tree) Bamboo stakes cheaper 0.08ea (1 per tree) 700 + 80

Weed management and hole digging  $\sim$ \$100ph (approx 4h \$330 for 300 trees) so average 1 hour, \$100 per 75 trees. So 1000 trees = \$1300

total for 1000 trees = \$5080 = \$5 per tree

#### **Annual timeline VIC:**

JAN Sow seedlings

FEB Finalise planting sites

MAR Finalise planting plans with landowners, promotion of planting events

APR Finalise dates & promotion

MAY Finalise weed management, promotion to planters

JUN Plant. Organise hole digging (Jun) & weed management (Jul)

JUL Plant. Organise hole digging (Jul) & weed management (Aug)

AUG Plant. Organise hole digging (Aug)

SEP Plan & promote community information event

OCT Letterbox drops & media

NOV Order trees, start agreements with landowners

DEC Visit sites, order extra trees if needed
